### IRREGULAR ROUTE COMMON CARRIER CERTIFICATE

CERTIFICATE NO. 8776

After a hearing on October 8, 1986, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") approved the application for transfer of Certificate No. 8776 to VALLEY TOWING, INC., 152 Merrimack St., Methuen, MA 01844.

The transfer is subject to such terms and conditions as the Department may hereafter lawfully attach to the Certificate as the public convenience and necessity may require, and to such rules and regulations as the Department may from time to time prescribe, and to the right of the Department to revoke or suspend said Certificate for violations of any of the provisions of Chapter 159B of the General Laws, as amended, and the regulations and Orders of the Department made under authority thereof, after a hearing at least ten days' notice of which shall be given to the holder of said Certificate.

This Certificate is restricted to the transportation of commodities described and within the limits set forth in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

IRREGULAR ROUTE  
COMMON CARRIER  
CERTIFICATE NO. 8776

This certificate is issued for the transportation of used motor vehicles within a 75 mile radius of City Hall, Lowell.

CONDITION OF ISSUANCE

The carrier is required at all times to maintain standards and conduct which in the opinion of the Department are satisfactory to establish proof of its continuing fitness, willingness and ability to perform the service authorized herein.

CONDITIONS OF INSURANCE

This certificate is issued upon the condition that the holder thereof shall at all times be insured by an insurance company authorized to issue such insurance in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts against liability for loss of or damage to property belonging to another and in possession of the holder of this certificate in connection with its transportation service, provided, however, that such insurance may be limited to 5,000. upon any one load and to \$5,000. upon any one claim for loss of or damage to property transported on any one vehicle, and provided further that said holder is not required to be so insured as to vehicles used exclusively in the transportation of commodities in bulk suitable for dump unloading. The cargo insurance endorsement authorized by the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities must be attached to and made a part of the cargo insurance policy.
